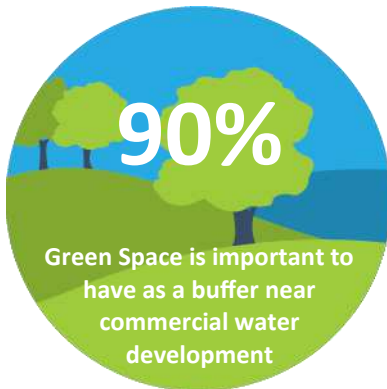
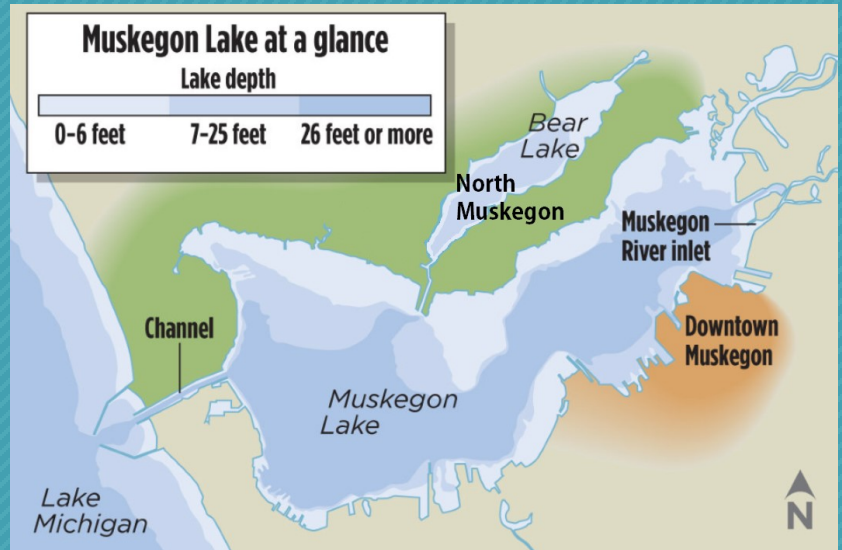
Natural Recreation should occupy **25% or more** of the shoreline
